1. A paint chip found at the scene of a car accident, is the paint chip class or individual evidence? Why?
2. A lip print was found on a glass at the crime scene; class or individual evidence? Why?
3. A vase was shattered, are the pieces individual or class evidence? Why?
4. A torn t-shirt was found in the back seat of a suspect's car. Two pieces of cloth were found at the crime scene, are the pieces individual or class evidence? (this could be both be sure to defend your argument)
5. There is a piece of paper ripped out of something at the crime scene, there is a notepad on Mr. Alster's desk that looks the same.....can we individualize the note at the crime scene to Mr. Alster's notepad? Why or why not?
6. A piece of paper is found to be cut into several pieces at the crime scene, are the pieces considered class or individual? Why?
